As of the date of this bulletin, there are 21,234 registered sex offenders living in the State of Wisconsin of which, 5992 are in prison, 5,110 are on probation/parole or extended supervision and 10,222 who are completely discharged from supervision. Fond du Lac County has 220 registered sex offenders.

SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION BULLETIN

The Fond du Lac County Sheriff's Office is releasing the following information pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 301.45 and 301.46 (Act 440), which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender's release when, at the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with the local law enforcement agencies. Further, his previous criminal history places the offender in a classification level which reflects the potential to re-offend.

This sex offender has served the sentence imposed on him by the courts and has advised officials he will be living at N8578 Nitschke Rd, Van Dyne, WI in the Town of Eldorado. THIS PERSON IS NOT WANTED BY THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE AT THIS TIME. THIS NOTIFICATION IS NOT INTENDED TO INCREASE FEAR; RATHER, IT IS OUR BELIEF THAT AN INFORMED PUBLIC IS A SAFER PUBLIC.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities but it was not until passage of Act 440 (which mandates sex offender registration) that law enforcement even knew where they were living. In many cases, law enforcement is now able to share that information with you. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate, or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated. Further, such abuse could potentially end law enforcement's ability to do community notification. We believe the only person who wins if community notification ends is the sex offender, since sex offenders derive their power through secrecy.

Dennis R. Thiel is being released from Sand Ridge Secure Treatment Center. Thiel will be released on April 29, 2010 after being under secure supervision since 1993 for 1st Degree Sexual Assault of a Child.

In 1987 Thiel was convicted of sexually assaulting a 9 year old female who was known to him. While on probation, in 1993 Thiel was convicted of sexually assaulting an 11 yr old female who was known to him. Thiel completed his prison term in 1997 and remained confined under Chapter 980 Civil Commitment. He was recently granted supervised release by the court and must be returned to the community no later than 4/29/10. Thiel will be placed under strict supervision by the Department of Health Services through the Wisconsin Department of Corrections. Thiel will be living at N8578 Nitschke Rd, Van Dyne, WI in the town of Eldorado.

The Fond du Lac County Sheriff's Office will distribute flyers to Thiel's neighborhood before his release. The Sheriff's Office will also be notifying schools and other community partners who operate in the area of release.

Special conditions of Dennis R. Thiel's supervised release:

No unsupervised contact with minors; no presence in taverns, bars, or liquor stores; no contact with victim; and no use of alcohol or illegal drugs.

Comply with all rules of high risk sex offender supervision; cooperate with electronic monitoring and GPS.

Face-to-face contact with law enforcement as required.

Comply with all rules of WI Sex Offender Registration Program.

Dennis R. Thiel will be living at N8578 Nitschke Rd, Van Dyne, WI in the Town of Eldorado when he is initially released as an inpatient from the Department of Health Services/Sand Ridge Secure Treatment Center on April 29, 2010.
