2012 BOATER SAFETY CLASS

The Fond du Lac County Sheriff's Office will be conducting a Boater Safety Course to be held at the Emergency Government Center – 160 S. Macy Street, Fond du Lac, Wisconsin. Entrance will be from the north parking lot located off of Second Street.

Boater education certification is required by law for anyone born on or after 01/01/89 and 16 years old or older before they may operate a motorboat.

The course will be held on the following dates:

May 15, 2012 6:00 – 8:30 pm

May 17, 2012 6:00 – 8:30 pm

May 22, 2012 6:00 – 8:30 pm

May 24, 2012 6:00 – 8:30 pm

Students **must** attend all four nights. Parents must attend the first night for approximately 15 minutes to register with student. Ages 10 to 15 preferred. Cost of the class is \$10 (**cash only**). Class size is limited so you **must** pre-register. To pre-register call Deputy Aaron Rauls at (920) 906-4664 ext. 9062.

All boater safety students will now be required to obtain a WI DNR Customer ID Number as part of the criteria to graduate from any Recreational Safety class and provide that WI DNR Customer ID Number to their instructor.

Students can obtain a DNR customer ID Number by calling 1-888-936-7463 between the hours of 7AM – 10 PM. When calling you will need to provide the following information:

1. Full name of student
2. Date of Birth
3. Height
4. Weight
5. Hair Color
6. Eye Color
7. Social Security Number (optional)

Please obtain your WI DNR Customer ID# as soon as possible and bring this completed form to Deputy Aaron Rauls on May 15, 2012.
